APA Citation Creators

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Make sure that you reformat them with hanging indent and double space and put them in alphabetical order for your reference page.(clear formatting will help in you are coping from these cites)

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This is a great place to check and see if you have your citations correct.

In-text citations are in the Author Date format. You must include page or paragraph numbers if you are using a quote.
